Know Before You Go

Location: Improvised Electronics is located Barrio Logan, an artistic, industrial neighborhood with Mexican roots, minutes from downtown San Diego. We are walking distance to a handful of lunch spots, taco shops, art galleries and craft breweries, 1 mile from the Gaslamp District & Petco Park and less than 5 miles from the airport and Coronado Beach.

Getting Around: Given our close proximity to hotel and entertainment options, we highly recommend using a rideshare service (i.e. Uber, Lyft). Some students prefer to rent a car. Keep in mind that parking can be pricey at the hotels and difficult in other places around town. There is limited free two hour parking in front of our shop and a free all day parking structure 2 blocks away.

Hotel Recommendations: Our students like the Embassy Suites by Hilton San Diego Bay Downtown. The hotel is conveniently located to our shop and serves complimentary drinks during their evening Happy Hour and in the morning, a free made-to-order breakfast.

Schedule of Events: Day 1 will focus on Eagle CAD and Fusion 360. On day 2 we will focus on bringing software drawings to life with FDM (Prusa / Ender) and SLS 3D (Fuse 1) printing. The final day we will cover milling PCBs with Bantam Tools and Arduino on a breadboard.
